**Digital X-rays** – are much more comfortable and efficient than traditional X-rays and expose you and our team to less radiation. The high-quality images captured can be shared immediately with our patients so we can discuss what we see and store those images for easy reference for future appointments.



**iTero Intraoral Scanner** – is a touch-enabled scanner that produces a precise view of your mouth, gums, teeth, and all other oral structures. We use this device to create digital impressions (no tray full of goop to bite into) for Invisalign, implants, dentures, and more.

**CBCT** – Cone-beam computed tomography systems rotate around the patient's head and neck, capturing data through a cone-shaped X-ray beam. We can use the data to reconstruct three-dimensional (3D) images of your anatomy, specifically the teeth, entire mouth, jaw joints, neck, ears, nose, and throat.

Modern dentistry offers so many possibilities when it comes to your smile. No one has to live with missing, crooked, or stained teeth. Jaw pain is not normal and is completely treatable. Interrupted sleep due to blocked airways can often be treated with a simple dental appliance. If stress or genetics has you grinding your teeth, we can help.



You do not need to live with severely worn teeth or missing teeth. Not only can this change the shape of your face, it can cause issues such as jawbone deterioration. No matter what age you might be, you deserve a beautiful smile and the ability to eat the foods you love. Even more concerning, studies show missing teeth are tied to an increased risk of dementia, stroke, diabetes and even cancer.

Our team is here to help you have the best oral health possible to enhance your overall wellness and quality of life. Nothing boosts your confidence and enjoyment in life like a great smile.

Modern dentistry can replace missing teeth with implants or dentures. We can create same-day crowns to cover damaged teeth, use veneers to cover stained or cracked teeth, and fill in gaps. We can also straighten those pearly whites with Invisalign in less time than you might think.

#### TREATMENT OF SLEEP APNEA/TMD

Millions of Americans have jaw issues that obstruct their airways and interrupt their sleep. Left untreated, this medical condition can lead to severe health problems. If we see evidence of sleep apnea, we can correct your jaw alignment and open obstructed airways with a custom-built appliance to wear at night.

When your jaw joints are out of alignment it can cause unpleasant symptoms, such as:

- · Popping and cracking when eating, talking, or yawning
- · A sensation of the jaw joint locked in place
- Neck and back pain
- Sleep apnea


After graduating from Bishop Moore Catholic high school in Orlando, Dr.
